Dear Sun Peaks Utilities Co., Ltd.,

Re: Registration Amendment under the Municipal Wastewater Regulation

Pursuant to Section 8 of the Municipal Wastewater Regulation, Registration RE-1535 is hereby amended to require Sun Peaks Utilities Co. Ltd. to create and maintain a replacement reserve maintenance trust fund.

The following requirements apply to the replacement reserve maintenance trust fund:

- Sun Peaks Utilities Co. Ltd. shall contribute \$50,000 per year commencing in the 2014 calendar year to the trust fund up to a maximum of \$1,000,000,
- Funds shall only be withdrawn with the approval or pursuant to a plan prepared by a “Qualified Professional” as defined in the Municipal Wastewater Regulation,
- An update on the status of the account shall be provided to the Ministry in the annual wastewater treatment plant report, and,
- Funds are to be used for the purpose of addressing any major repairs or required changes to the wastewater collection and treatment facilities.

In accordance with the registration amendment request received on February 18, 2014, the Registered maximum daily discharge rate is hereby changed from 1,000 m³/day to 1,100 m³/day.



All other terms and conditions of the Registration remain in full force. Your attention is respectfully directed to the terms and conditions specified in the Municipal Wastewater Regulation. Contravention of any of the conditions is a violation of the Environmental Management Act and may result in prosecution. If the Municipal Wastewater Regulation does not cover all waste streams at the site, additional authorizations may be required under the Environmental Management Act.

Registration under the Municipal Wastewater Regulation does not authorize entry upon, crossing over, or use for any purpose of private or Crown lands or works, unless and except as authorized by the owner of such lands or works. The responsibility for obtaining such authority rests with the operator. It is also the responsibility of the operator to ensure that all activities conducted under the Municipal Wastewater regulation are carried out with regard to the rights of third parties, and comply with other applicable legislation that may be in force. The operator must also obtain any necessary approvals from other agencies.

Administration of this regulation will be carried out by staff from the ministry regional office. Plans, data and reports pertinent to the Municipal Wastewater Regulation are to be submitted to the Regional Director, Environmental Protection, at the regional office indicated above.
